

## He'll Do it Again

God never changes; He is the same yesterday, today and forever (Heb. 13:8). What He can do once, He can do it again.

### 1. The Lord is consistent, a promise keeper.

- 1.1. "I am the Lord, and I do not change" (Mal. 3:6).
- 1.2. "Remember the former things, those long ago; I am God, and there is no one like Me. At the end beginning I declare the outcome; from of old, things not yet done. I say that My plan shall stand, I accomplish My every desire" (Is. 46:9-10).

### 2. Do not forget God's goodness in the past.

- 2.1. Moses reminded his people of how the Lord's strong hand brought them out of Egypt (Dt. 7:17-19).
- 2.2. "Bless the Lord, my soul; all my being, bless His holy Name! Bless the Lord, my soul; and do not forget all His gifts" (Ps. 103:1-2).

### 3. The Christian song, "Do It Again" by Elevation Worship, beautifully explains this:

- 3.1. Walking around these walls, I thought by now they'd fall. But You have never failed me yet.
  - In Joshua 6, the walls of Jericho fell down when the Israelites obeyed God's command to circle the city for seven days, and on the seventh day, blow their trumpets and give a loud shout.
  - We must remember that God, who brought down the walls of Jericho, can take down our own walls today if we obey.
- 3.2. Waiting for change to come, knowing the battle's won
  - The battle is not ours but God's (2 Chron. 20:15). We have only to fight the good fight of faith.
- 3.3. Your promise still stands. Great is Your faithfulness.
  - God is the great promise-keeper.
  - He spoke creation into being (Heb. 11:3). He healed the Centurion's servant just as

he believed (Mt. 8:13). He promised Joshua the same land that He promised Moses (Josh. 1).

- His goodness is new every morning (Lam. 3:22-23). He will not allow us to have problems beyond our means (1 Cor. 10:13).
- 3.4. I'm still in Your hands. This is my confidence. You never failed me yet.
    - The hand of the Lord is not too short to save, nor His ear too dull to hear" (Is. 59:1).
    - "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me." (Jn 14:1,6)
  - 3.5. I know the night won't last. Your words will come to pass.
    - God works at the eleventh hour. In Acts 16 at midnight, Paul and Silas were set free from prison.
    - Whatever word God speaks shall happen without delay (Ez. 12:25). "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away" (Mt 24:35).
  - 3.6. My heart will sing Your praise again.
    - When we are praising God, we focus on His attributes rather than on our problems.
  - 3.7. I see You move, You move the mountains. I believe I'll see You do it again.
    - "Let it be done for you according to your faith" (Mt 9:29).

The Lord has been our healer, provider, savior, way maker, shelter and friend. God, who has seen us through seasons of difficulties, is able to do it again.

Reflection:

Whenever a new problem arises, do you grumble and forget what God has done in the past?

We must remember to keep holding on to our faith. He has delivered us before, and He will surely do it again.
