

## OBEDIENCE WORKS

Part 3 of 4 Part Series

Ezra 5:2 "Thereupon Zerubbabel, son of Shealtiel, and Jeshua, son of Jozadak, began again to build the house of God in Jerusalem, with the prophets of God giving them support." (NABRE)

Why is it that leaders and managers don't do what we perceive as "hard jobs"? Why aren't they on the pole changing electric cables, or in manholes fixing the drain? This is because a leader's job is the bigger picture.

The leader oversees and makes sure that everybody does what is assigned to them. Zerubbabel and Jeshua, together with prophets Haggai and Zecharia (Ezra 5:2), got everyone involved in building the church.
