1. Great People with their mother by their side.

- 1.2 King Solomon, who was like his father King David, was also a great and powerful king. He was supported by his mother, Bathsheba. Solomon loved and honored her by making her sit on a throne on his right. He understood the importance of a mother on his side.
- 1.3 Jesus whose Mother Mary taught and took good care of Him was with Him from childhood until his passion and death on the cross. Jesus acknowledged her on the cross. He interrupted the salvation of mankind to make sure his mother would be looked after (Luke 2).
