"THE UGLINESS OF CHRISTMAS"

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We all think that Christmas is the most beautiful time of the year considering all the colorful Christmas lights, decorations, jolly parties, and giftgiving. It is the joy of many preachers to speak about the beauty of Christmas and the wonderful events that took place in Bethlehem. However, to have a proper understanding of the beauty of Christmas, we also need to know its true meaning and its ugliness as well.

1. What is the beauty and true meaning of Christmas?

It is important to know that the meaning of Christmas is sharing. The most precious gift to mankind is from our heavenly Father when He sent His Son to us wrapped in swaddling clothes. - 3.3 SIN is ungratefulness. God gave us so much but we are not thankful for them. We complain and we are never satisfied.
- 3.4 SIN is incurable. It is like a disease that can only be cured by the blood of Jesus (Jeremiah 2:22).
- 3.5 SIN is hated by God. It is the only thing that God has eternal hatred for because it separates us from Him.
- 3.6 SIN is hard work. All sin causes pain and yet people go through pain to do it.
- 3.7 SIN is bondage. It brings us under the dominance of Satan.
- 3.8 SIN sends men to hell. We are often targeted with the arrow of fire of Satan in our minds; thus, we are tempted to sin.
- 3.9 SIN is the ugliness of Christmas but it ultimately brings us to the point of its beauty. The beauty of Christmas is that Jesus came to deliver us from sin.
