Many of us experience a point in our lives when we face impossible situations. This is a fact of life and the challenge for us is how to face these seemingly impossible situations in life. We need to understand this concept of impossibility, which was closely associated with power in the time of Jesus. Indeed, God has the power to make things possible.

1. God's power made things possible in the following events:

1.1. The Story of Elizabeth

Elizabeth, said to be barren, conceived John the Baptist in her old age (Luke 1:5-19)

1.2 The Annunciation

The angel declared to Mary that she was chosen to bear the Son of God. She conceived even without having relations with a man (Luke 1:35).

1.3 The Nativity

The birth of Jesus and the events around it was full of impossibilities, but God made everything possible through the Holy Spirit (Luke 1 and 2).

1.4 The Story of Simeon

When Mary and Joseph presented the Child Jesus in the temple, the Holy Spirit empowered Simeon to know that the Child Jesus would become the light for revelation to the Gentiles and the glory of God's people, Israel (Luke 2:28-32)

1.5 Mary and Joseph as parents to Jesus

Being a parent to the Son of God was the most difficult job in the world because there were so many impossibilities surrounding it. They needed the Holy Spirit to make things possible (Philippians 4:13).

2. When and what should we do when we encounter impossible situations in our life?



2.1. God is commissioning us to an impossible task or mission.

The task or mission may be difficult but not impossible if we depend on Him to intervene and empower us.

2.2. God is doing something impossible in and through us.

- Mary was a very ordinary woman yet was chosen by God to be an instrument of the impossible – to be the mother of the Son of God.
- Sis. Techie Rodriguez, the Lord's Flock Elder and Founder, was inspired and tasked by God to build the Heritage Formation Center. The Heritage construction began with the many obstacles and seemed impossible. However, the moment she yielded to God and depended 100% on Him, the impossible became possible.
