## THE LORD'S FLOCK GROW DIGEST

1. **Develop a positive (optimistic) and confident outlook towards life.** In the spiritual realm, a positive attitude reflects the image of Christ to the people we interact daily. In the midst of negativity, we can infect others by:

- 1.1 Keeping an attitude of optimism in all situations;
- 1.2 Expecting a positive outcome when dealing with life's challenges;
- 1.3 Associating with positive thinking people and getting encouragement from people with strong faith;
- 1.4 Concentrating on the solutions and not on the problem;
- 1.5 Looking for lessons in both successes and mistakes; and
- 1.6 Turning our bad situations into teachable moments.

Nothing can keep God's love away from us, for we are more than conquerors (Rom. 8:35-37). The overwhelming victory is ours because God's loving control over our lives will cause us to triumph over whatever we may face.
