THE LORD'S FLOCK GROW DIGEST

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The God we serve is not a God of emptiness or silence – He is the God of miracles, signs and wonders. From the beginning of Scripture to the end of time, we have a God who consistently reveals Himself through supernatural acts that defy human reasoning and explanation.

1. What are “**Signs and Wonders**”? In the Bible, signs and wonders refer to the supernatural events that demonstrate God’s power and purpose.

1.1. A “*sign*” is a miraculous event or object that signifies something beyond itself, often pointing to God’s purpose or confirming His promises.

1.2. A “*wonder*” is a miraculous event that evokes amazement and awe; it demonstrates or highlights the extra-ordinary power of God.

2. **God reveals His power through signs and wonders** (Isa. 8:18). He uses these to demonstrate that He is sovereign over all creation, that He has supremacy over nature, sickness and death. It is part of His covenant with His people.

3. **Miracles reveal God’s glory and inspire faith.** Every miracle is a revelation of God’s power, character and nature and a call to deeper belief. God intervenes beyond what we can accomplish. What God does for one becomes faith fuel for others (Jn. 11:43-45).

4. **Miracles are received when we believe and expect divine intervention.** They happen through our deep faith. It is our faith that determines our experience of the miraculous (Jn. 11:40).

5. **Believers will be accompanied by signs and wonders** (Mk. 16:17). Miracles and supernatural events will naturally follow those who trust in Jesus. He wants us to be His miracle ground.

6. **The Five (5) signs of a believer** (Mk. 16:17-18):

6.1 Casting out demons: showing authority over spiritual evil (Lk. 10:19). Nothing can harm us.

6.2 Speaking with new tongues: speaking in languages the speaker has never learned. The Word of God has been translated in many languages.

6.3 Handling serpents (Acts 28:3): supernatural protection from natural or physical harm. Believers recognize and expose false doctrine.

6.4 Drinking deadly poison: being unharmed by anything deadly (like Daniel, Shadrack et al).

6.5 Laying hands on the sick: God uses believers as vessels to restore health by placing hands on those who are ill (Acts 3).

These signs do not come automatically. They are activated by FAITH, for Jesus said that these would follow those who believe. We will be blessed wherever we are (Deut. 28).

Conclusion: God is in the business of signs and wonders. He is not a dead God or a powerless deity – He is alive, active and able to intervene supernaturally. He does not change: What He did before, He is still doing. Whether it is parting of the Red Sea, provision of daily manna, healing the sick, or lifting a soul from despair. These miracles are available to every believer who walks in faith and obedience.

Reflection: How has God manifested His power in your life through signs and wonder?

Prayer: *Heavenly Father, increase our faith. We trust You beyond our own human senses, understanding and experience so that we can fully experience your miracles, signs and wonders through the Holy Spirit’s anointing. In Jesus’ Name. AMEN!*
